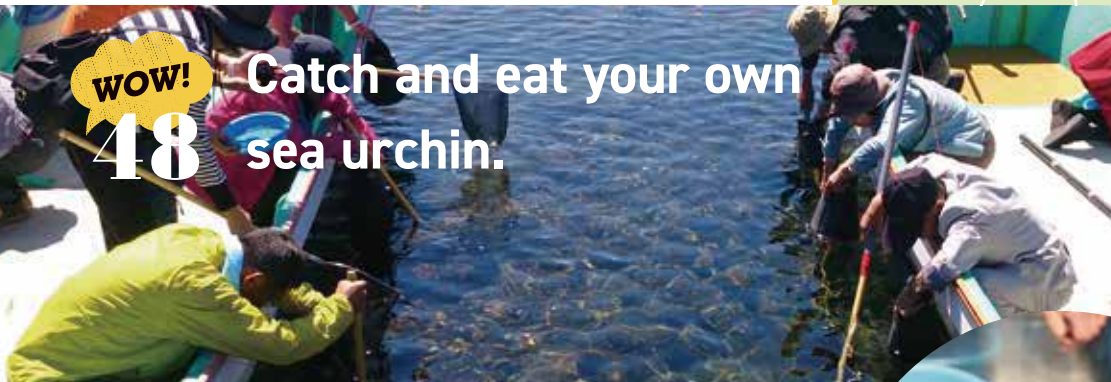

Climb the northernmost of Japan's Top 100 peaks.



Known as Rishirifuji, the 1,721-m-high Mt. Rishiri is one of Japan's Top 100 peaks. The view from the summit is something special. There are two mountain trails for intermediate and experienced climbers, with the ascent taking approximately six hours, and the decent approximately four.
