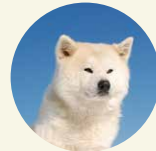
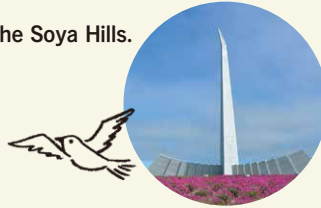


# WOW! 50 INDEX

- 16** \_\_\_\_\_ Lots of fun to be had at Japan's northernmost multipurpose complex.
- 17** \_\_\_\_\_ Learn about the history of Karafuto and Wakkanai.
- 18** \_\_\_\_\_ Learn Russian, in some vague way, from the direction signs around the city.
- 19** \_\_\_\_\_ Why not wear a kimono and take a stroll around town?
- 20** \_\_\_\_\_ See the 360-degree panoramic view from the Founding Centennial Tower.
- 21** \_\_\_\_\_ Follow the cherry blossoms to the northernmost point.

- 32** \_\_\_\_\_ Dance the "Hokkai Teppen Dance" and "Nankyoku Dance" at the Wakkanai Minato Nankyoku Festival in early August.
