## Experience at first hand the unique nature (topography) of the Soya Hills.

The Soya Hills, where gentle green undulations extend as far as the eye can see, were created approximately 10,000 years ago due to repeated freezing and thawing during the Ice Age. The trees were destroyed in a forest fire during the Meiji Period, to reveal beautiful terrain conceived by ancient dramas.



#### TOPICS

### The Periglacial Landform of the Soya Hills

Gentle wave-like terrain, carved away by rain and river water approximately 10,000 years ago, designated a Hokkaido Heritage in 2004.
